In 1971 the committee of opening The Prince Hotel School was established within the head quarter of the Prince Hotel Inc. and then in 1972 The Japan Hotel School began as The Prince Hotel School with 160 students. In 1976, The Japan Education Centre for the Hotel Industry was established for the purpose of supporting the development of the hospitality industry in Japan. To achieve this end, the Centre took over The Prince Hotel School and changed the name to The Japan Hotel School in that same year. In 1987 the part of The Japan Hotel School among activities of the Centre was authorized by the Ministry of Education in accordance with the guidelines of Education Law. In April 1st 2009, the



Japan Hotel School was donated by the Centre to the school foundation called as Japan Hotel Gakuin which was newly established with the approval of Tokyo Metropolitan Government in accordance with the guidelines of Education Law Japan, and became legally independent from the Centre.

Since its establishment in 1972, about 13,000 graduates are active in hotel industry in Japan and over the world. As a middle-management training institution of hotel management in Japan, we have formed our own education system based on the example of the Western hotel system in consideration of the domestic

school form. As an educational philosophy "To integrate their knowledge and experiences and to created new service", The Japan Hotel School provide theoretical education and practice education with the hotel internship programs, so that we offer a consistent education from service to management.

Under one of principles of education "To think and act based on global perspectives", we provide the Studying abroad system (Canada or Australia), the overseas study in Asia and Europe/America. In



2015, we organized Young Skal Club Japan with 78 students in our English course as a part of international education program. It is an example of the international education efforts. By 2019, 164 foreign students from Korea have graduated.
